HOW TO ADDRESS PUBLIC OFFICIALS

PRIMARY ELECTION:

Tuesday, June 24, 2025

(Early Voting Dates: June 14 – June 22, 2025)

To vote you **must** be enrolled in that political party.

GENERAL ELECTION:

Tuesday, November 4, 2025

(Early Voting Dates: October 25 – November 2, 2025)

To vote you must be a US citizen, 18 years old, a resident of Nassau County for 30 days and **you can register to vote up to ten days prior to an election.**

NOTE: Wherever possible, websites are included when e-mail addresses are not available. When using the Internet to communicate with a public official, it is advisable to include both your postal and e-mail addresses.

LEGISLATIVE STATUS OFFICE (202) 225-1772

The information available includes status of legislation in House and Senate and dates of committee hearings that have already taken place (not a schedule of future hearings).

Federal law makes these provisions for vacancies:

The President – Vice President becomes President.

The Vice President – The President nominates a Vice President who must be confirmed by majority vote of both houses of Congress. The legal order of succession after Vice President is Speaker of the House of Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, members of the Cabinet in a specified order beginning with the Secretary of State.

New York State law makes these provisions for vacancies:

US Senate – The Governor appoints someone to the office until the vacancy can be filled at a general election.

US House of Representatives – Depending upon date, vacancies are filled at a special election or the next general election.

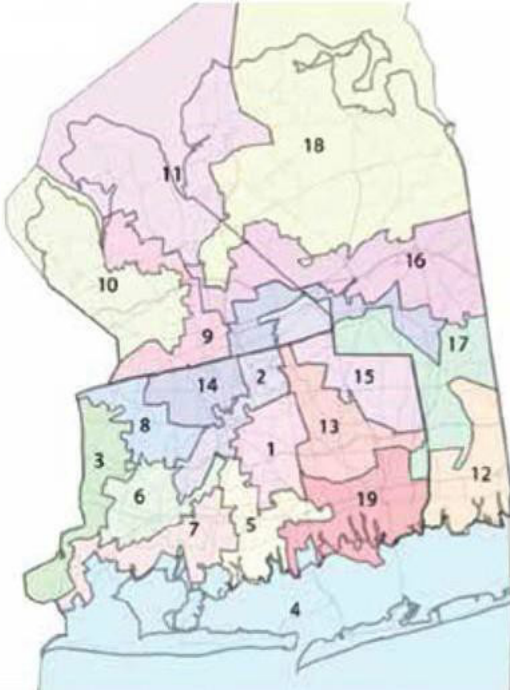
